ORDER:

The Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) was launched by the Government of Tamil Nadu as the Chief Minister Kalaignar's Insurance Scheme on 23.07.2009, to facilitate poor and low income group families to get cashless, sophisticated treatment for serious ailments, in Government and Private Hospitals, which they cannot otherwise afford. In view of its successful implementation, the Scheme has been continued till date covering 1.40 crore beneficiary families. The Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) has been integrated with the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) and under the integrated scheme, all the beneficiary families get health coverage upto Rs.5.00 lakh per year / per family.

- There are demands that the Scheme be improved further, be made more accessible and hassle free for poor patients to get treatment from both Government and private hospitals. The reimbursement process for hospitals also needs to be expedited.
